



Figure 1: Demographic transition in China, 1950-2050





Figure 3: Effect of ageing on the number of people suffering from at least one chronic (noncommunicable) disease in China, by sex, 2010, 2020 and 2030



UNITED STATES

- 44 million unpaid caregivers
- \$34 billion in employer loss of productivity due to caregiving

CANADA

- •4 out of 5 older adults are unsure they will get needed health services
- 61% doubt Canada's hospital and care facilities will meet the need

EUROPE

- 1/3 of Europeans as caregivers
- Only 7%Europeans report a parent in good health

BRAZIL

 Over 3.2 million elderly reported needing long-term care

SPAIN

- 20% of disabled elderly have unmet care needs
- Publicly funded home help only covers 3.5% of those over 65

SINGAPORE

- by 2030, 83,000 residents aged 60+ will need help
- This figure is 2.5 times larger than 2010

"Investing in long-term care helps older people with a significant loss of capacity to maintain lives of dignity and continued personal growth, but it can also protect families from impoverishment, allow women to remain in the workforce and foster social cohesion through the sharing of risk across a community. Much of the investment in infrastructure or policy to foster Healthy Ageing will also have direct benefits for other sections of the population." (World Health Organization)
